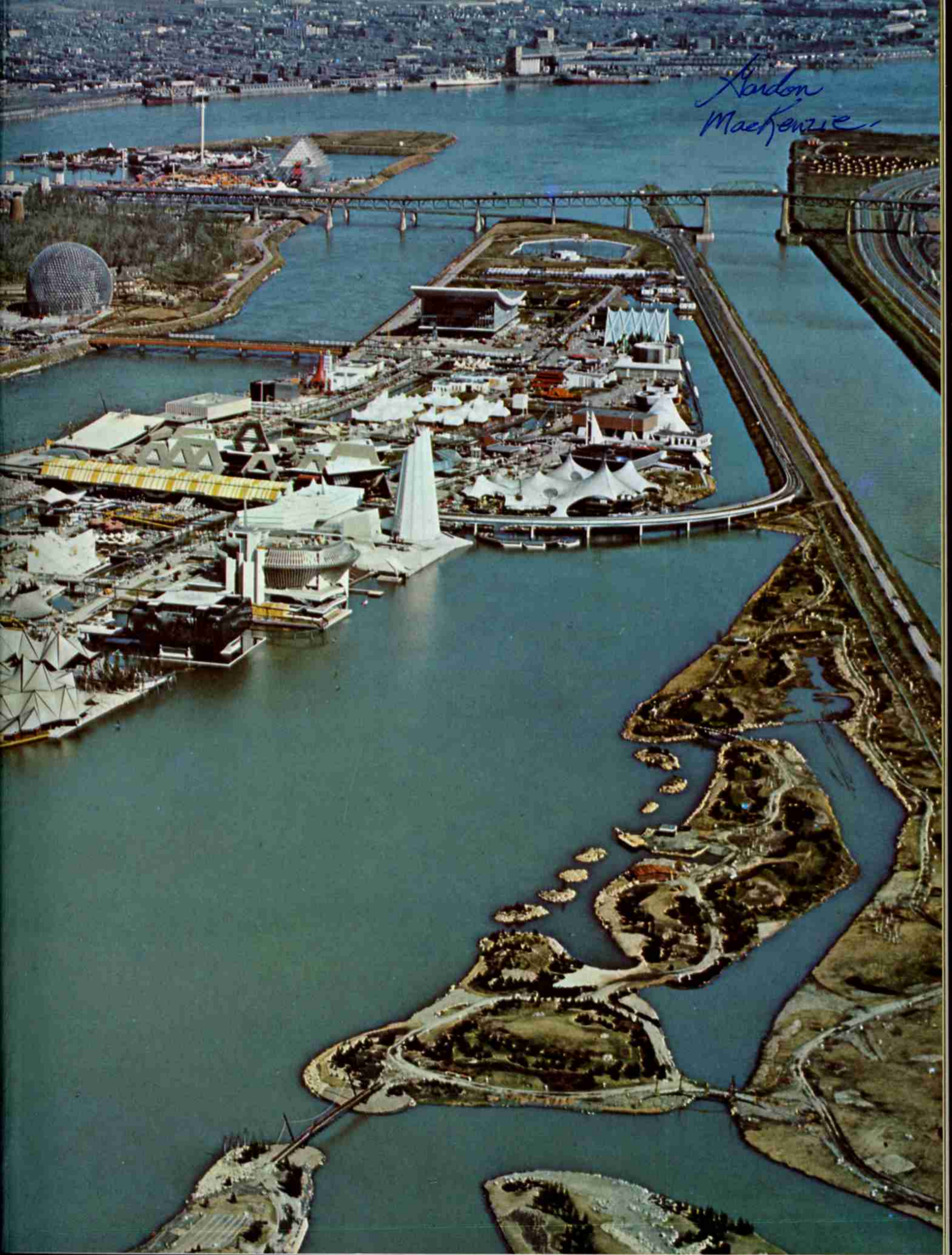




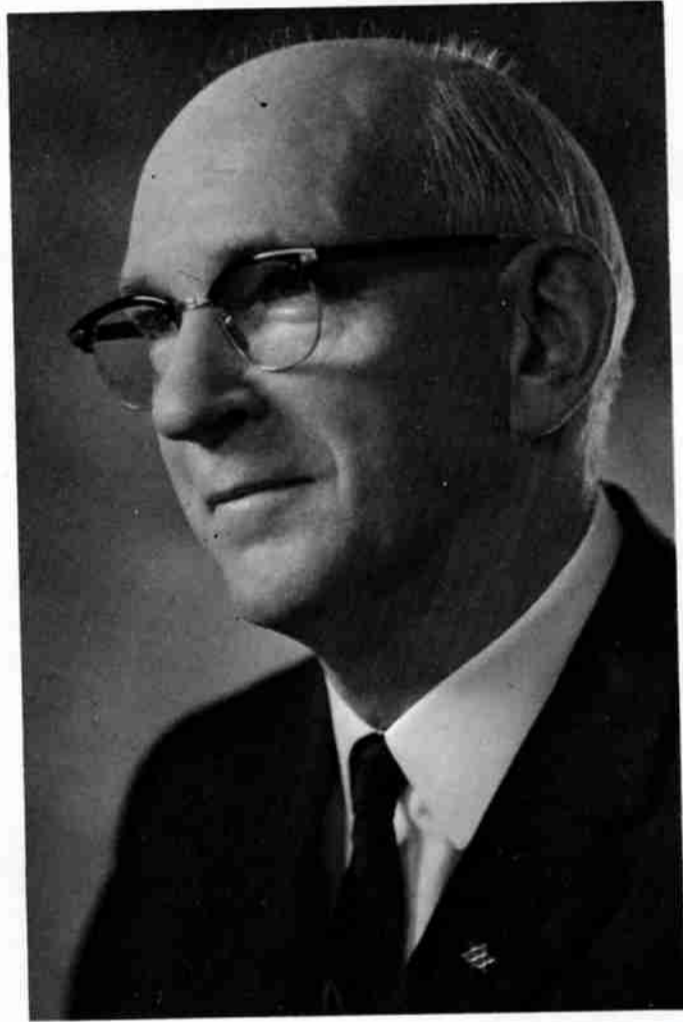

# Vice-Principal's Message

It is a pleasure to give hearty congratulations to the Yearbook Committee and to all other school organizations. My sincere thanks to all who have shown leadership and to all who have given active support.

Our Canadian way of life does not require all members of society to be leaders. But one of its principles is the fact of work, and each member is expected to contribute economically, socially and culturally. What have you to offer, and what are you prepared to do to improve the quality of what you offer?

However, you should realize that contributing to society need not conflict with seeking personal fulfillment. One needs a sense of proportion, and to learn how to command the self one has to live with.

In a constant attempt to improve the quality of instruction and activities offered at Bell, we have seen a number of changes this year. One of the most extensive has been the programme for our grade thirteen students. Their hour-long classes, location of classrooms, and special "privileges" regarding attendance, study rooms and lounge were all designed to better prepare our senior students for daily life at institutes of higher learning. For some this was a first opportunity to be the person directing his own activities and expenditure of energy. I'm sure that many realized for a first time that there can be no freedom or privileges without responsibility. The removal of province-wide examinations reduced the emphasis on outside evaluation and placed more emphasis on our own Scholarship Society. The increased number of marks allotted to term work for all grades encouraged a steady day-to-day application to studies. Changed methods of instruction were most noticeable in the History and Experimental English courses where opportunity was provided to do library research and to practice self-expression.

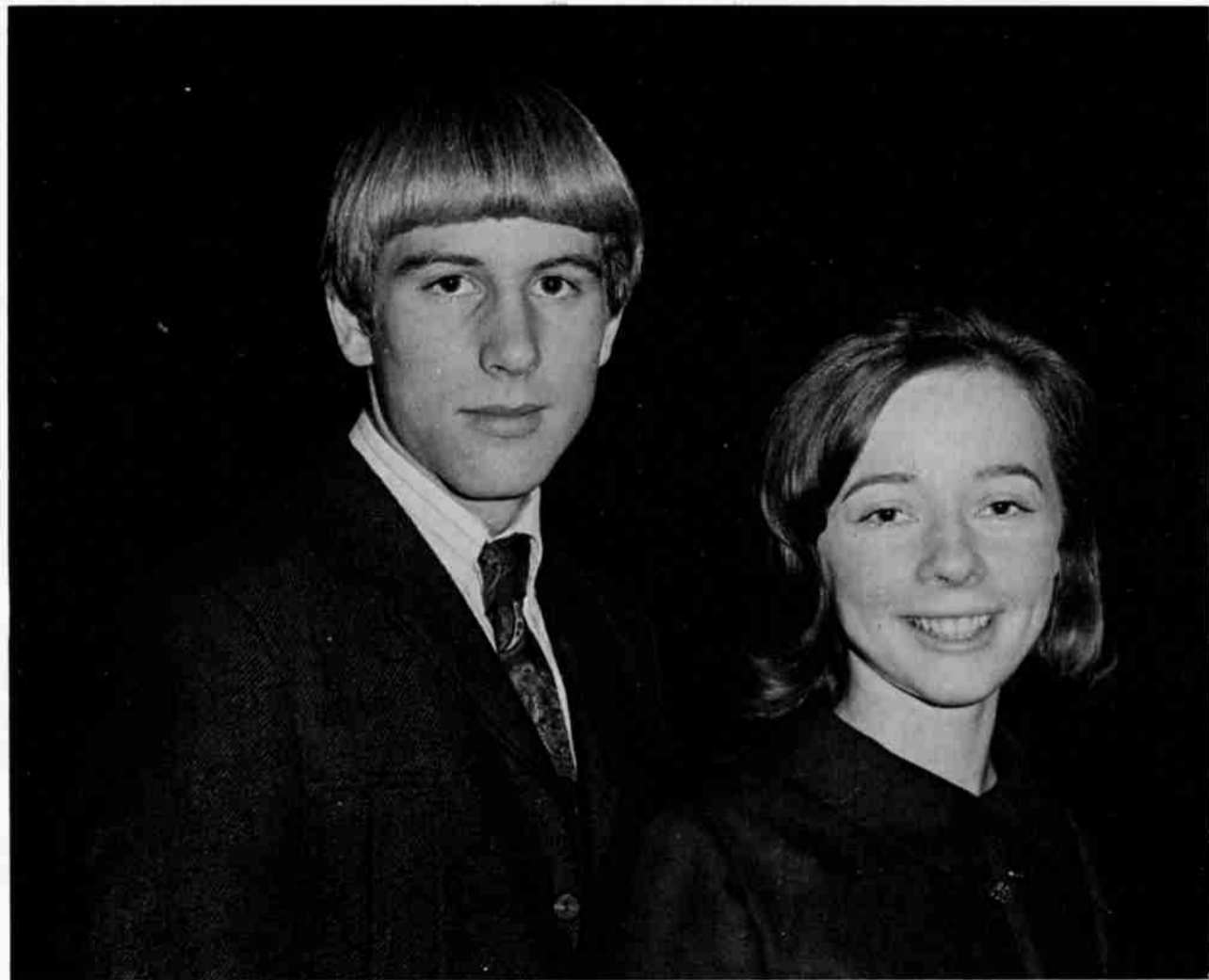
Our Students' Council '68 enthusiastically assisted all school clubs to organize and operate effectively. Among other innovations, a successful Initiation Programme was introduced in the fall and a Grade 13 Students' Lounge in the spring.

My best wishes for a successful future are extended to those who are leaving Bell this year. My sincerest wish is that we have all improved our sense of values. May we learn that everything is worth what its purchaser will pay for it, and we should ask before making a choice: "What is the price?"

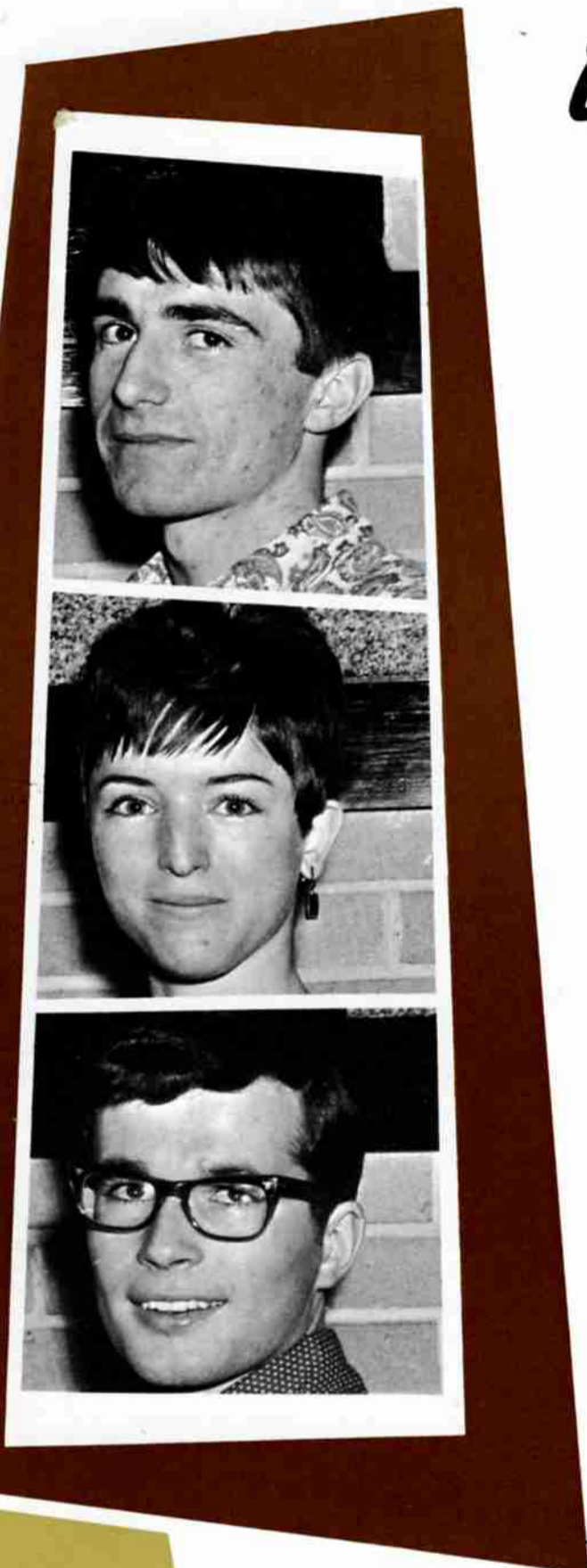

My interest in Bell was kindled even before it's walls had begun to rise. Then, with each succeeding month of 1962 while the building gradually assumed shape and substance, I watched its progress attentively. By September, though the school was far from complete, we were able to "move in".

Our assembly on the first day of school was held in the open — in the court beside the library (fortunately, a sunny day) — amid all sorts of building materials and construction equipment. That was a historic day with the coming together of twenty-seven teachers and six hundred students, all of them anticipating the thrill of classes in a new school.

In the years since 1962 Bell has assumed full stature. Its first real graduates — those who started to Bell in Grade 9 — have left. Already an impressive list of achievements has been recorded and numerous awards won in scholarship, athletics and other extra-curricular activities. My best wishes for a successful future go to all students of the school.

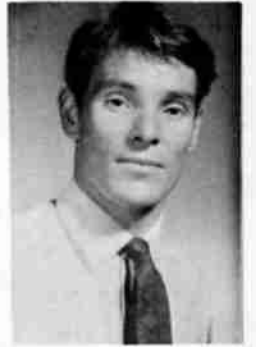
